# WHAT'S A HOUSING NPO?

- *It's a non-profit organization;*

*It's managed by a community organization with*

- *or without the tenants' involvement;*

*Rent is generally less high than on the private*

- *rental market (it's possible to access the Rent Supplement Program);*

*There are eligibility requirements to*

- *apply for housing in an NPO.*





## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

---

- *Be a Canadian citizen or have permanent residency*
- *Qualify as low-income*
- *Respect the NPO's mission*

# HOW TO GET A UNIT IN A HOUSING NPO



WRITE A COVER LETTER AND/OR FILL OUT A FORM.



EVERY NPO HAS ITS OWN WAITING LIST.



CANDIDATES GO THROUGH A PRELIMINARY SELECTION PROCESS TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY.



ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES ARE INVITED TO AN INTERVIEW WHEN A UNIT BECOMES AVAILABLE.



APPLICATIONS MUST BE RENEWED ACCORDING TO THE NPO'S CRITERIA.
